And since then I have had some experience making short films. So this review is based on some experience being taught and making simple films. Most of what I know either comes from the training I had and from the very good stuff available on the internet and more recently being on another HE video making course. Unfortunately, this book is well out of date. It was published in 2005, but seems to have been written around 2002/3. Technology had already moved on somewhat. Leaving this issue aside, I still think this is not a very good

book. The author tends to leave off just where you need to know more about the subject he is writing about. For example: he mentions log sheets, but skips over what you really need to know and doesn't give any useful example of one so the reader can see how to do it properly. The chapter on 'Using Lights' is particularly poor and his examples of lighting for video are frankly appalling. Overall, I can not recommend this book.
