However, I find the complete lack of chapter stops absolutely ridiculous. It's fine to encourage a straight-through hearing, but after that, it's pointless and aggravating to be denied the ability to jump to certain passages for further listening and study. What a poor decision someone made here. And I'm afraid that I find the project itself, and the resulting book, to be of scant interest. I'll stop just short of calling it "precious", or even "pretentious", but I'm at a loss to come up with a word to more precisely (and more graciously) describe my reaction to it. BE AWARE that it's difficult to find this package with the CD intact (at a reasonable price). ridiculous prices. Don't even be tempted; the book is nothing special, just a bunch of close-ups of the conductor's hands.
