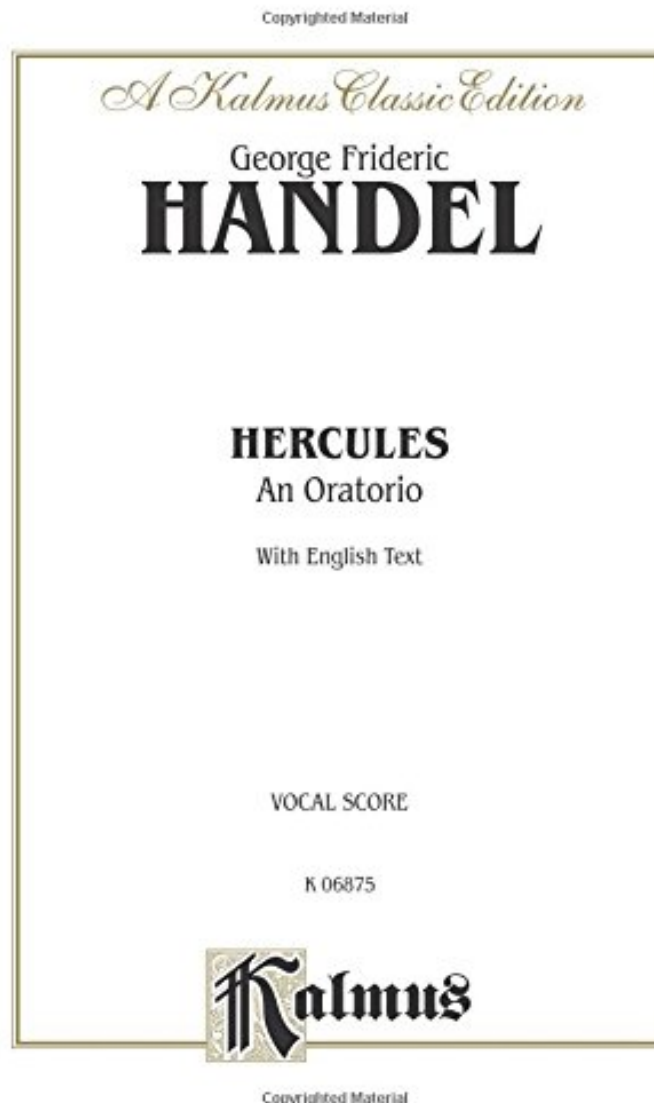

The score is complete and functional, but the print is horrible! It looks like someone photocopied each page a thousand times and used the final copy to make the book. Words and notes are blurry and fading, so it's very difficult to read. We are doing this opera in school, so everyone has a copy of this, and they all look the same, so I know mine is not a dud. Other than the print quality, my colleagues have mentioned the book is very cheaply put together. The rehearsal pianist has mentioned turning pages and, on multiple occasions, ripping the page straight out of the book. This is not a common experience for him with other opera/musical scores. Personally, I have not noticed any pages ripping out yet, but I tend to be more gentle and protective with books in general. I've had the book for several months now (including flattening the book to sit on a piano as I learn my part, etc) and the quality of mine is still good. Overall, I'm not super pleased with the quality of the book, but it's one of two editions of this opera. I don't know how the other score looks, but maybe try that one first? This just happened to be the one my school chose, so it may very well be more complete/accurate than the other edition. This edition is functional enough for a vocalist to learn their part and memorize outside of rehearsal, but I would absolutely not recommend it for sight reading or live performance as it is very hard to read and you will misread words and notes.
