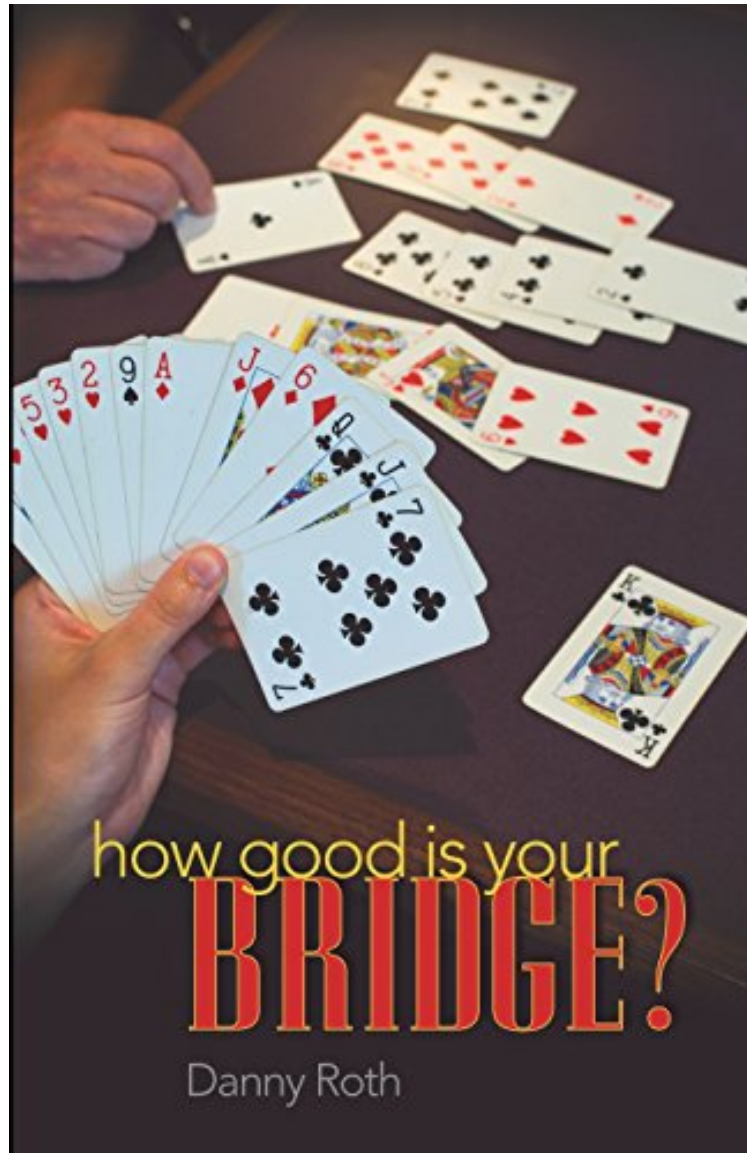

One of the nice things he does is give you the play of the first few tricks, then ask you a question, and then point out that the key decision point was actually a couple of tricks ago. In other words he doesn't tip you off that something special is happening and now is the time to think. This book has 2 sets of problems, declarer and

defense. The declarer problems were ok, geared towards Beginner/Intermediates. The defense problems were good in general, although I came up with alternative and plausible layouts that required a different solution. (In other words my answer was "wrong", but the chosen layout did not have to be the one based on the bidding - I was not convinced that the authors layout was the most reasonable). Overall - it's a good book for Beginner Intermediate players. If you are Advanced it's not worth the money.
