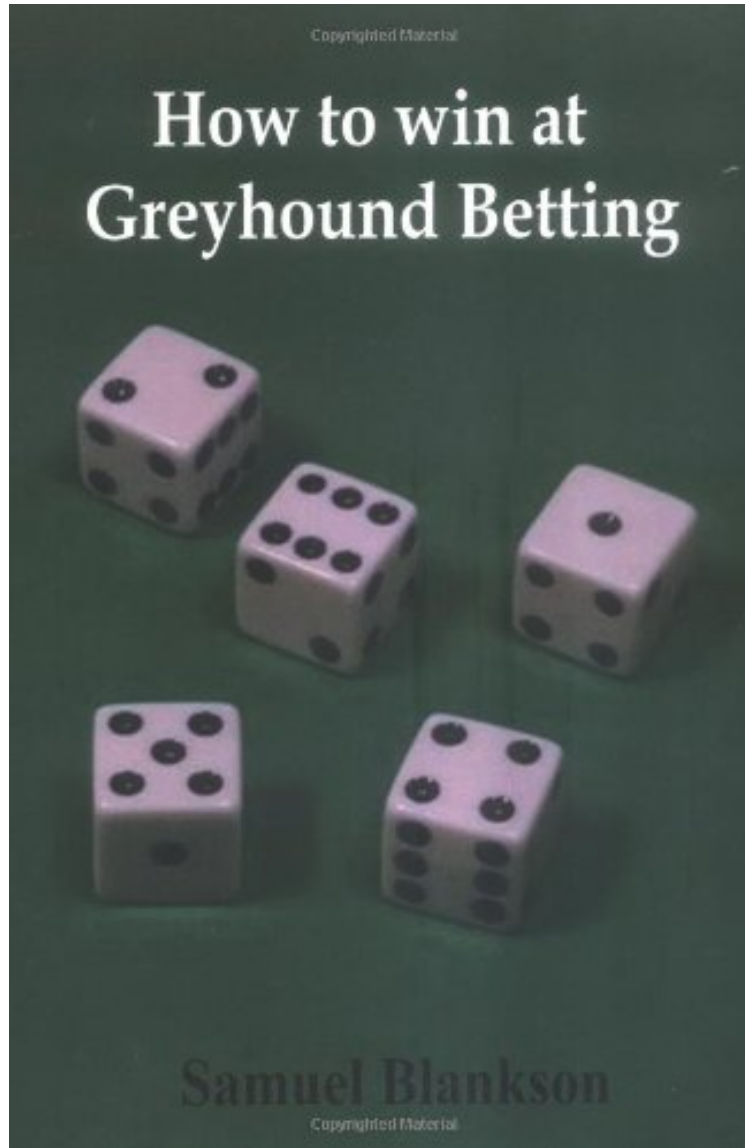

this one. It does not even pretend to mimic the popular topics. It breaks the mold and cuts out a whole new niche. If you are expecting to find out how to read form and pedigree of a greyhound in this book, you will be greatly disappointed. I have tried the form and pedigree methods and systems and find I still depended mostly on luck. With this book the author side steps all that and introduces some new and exciting rules and techniques. He gives over 10 systems for betting on greyhound races. Australian gamblers will be out of luck, unless you have internet access, as all the systems in this book, as far as I can see are based on the 6 trap race meetings found in the UK, and South Africa etc.. Whilst I havent tried and tested all these new techniques out personally, the few I have had time totry haveworked for me and in a funny way make sense to me, statistically.
