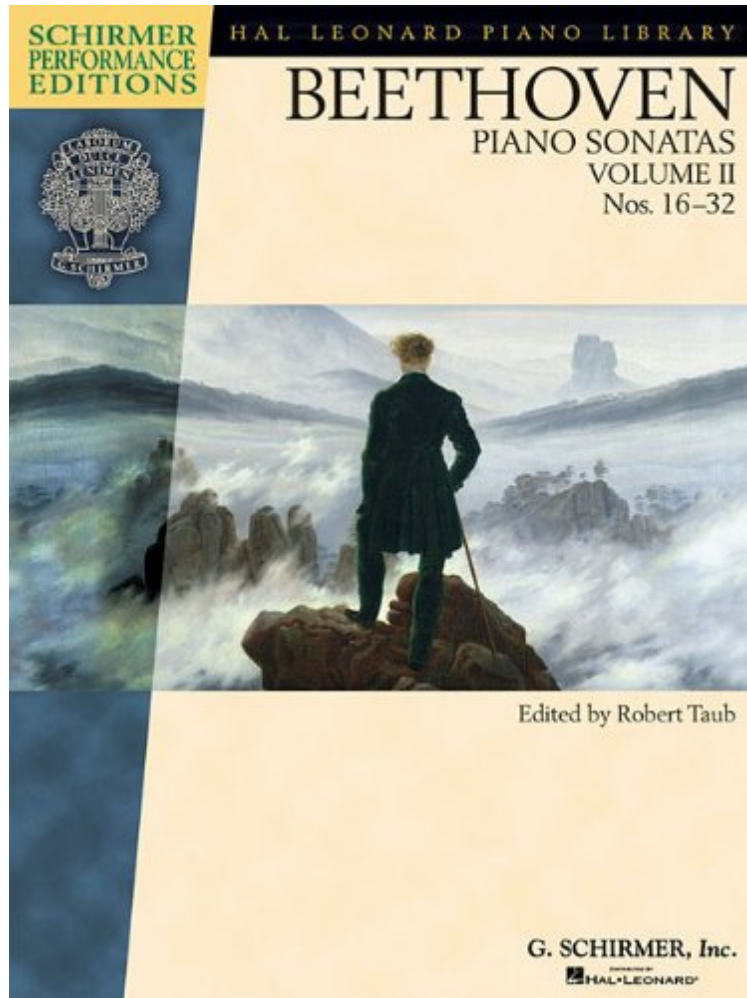

Tobias This is a very high quality edition of the Beethoven p. sonatas. The high quality cream color paper and clear dark printing are excellent. The physical quality is virtually identical with Henle editions, possibly every bit as good. I am not a professional or conservatory trained, so I cannot speak with any authority on the quality of the editing, but I can say that I find Taub's comments (condensed from his full length book) insightful and quite helpful. In fact, for non-professionals like me, this is probably a more useful edition than Henle thanks to the more extensive comments. Plus, it is far more economical than Henle, and in these tough economic times that is a consideration also. Professionals would probably find this a useful supplement to their preferred edition as well. Highly recommended.
