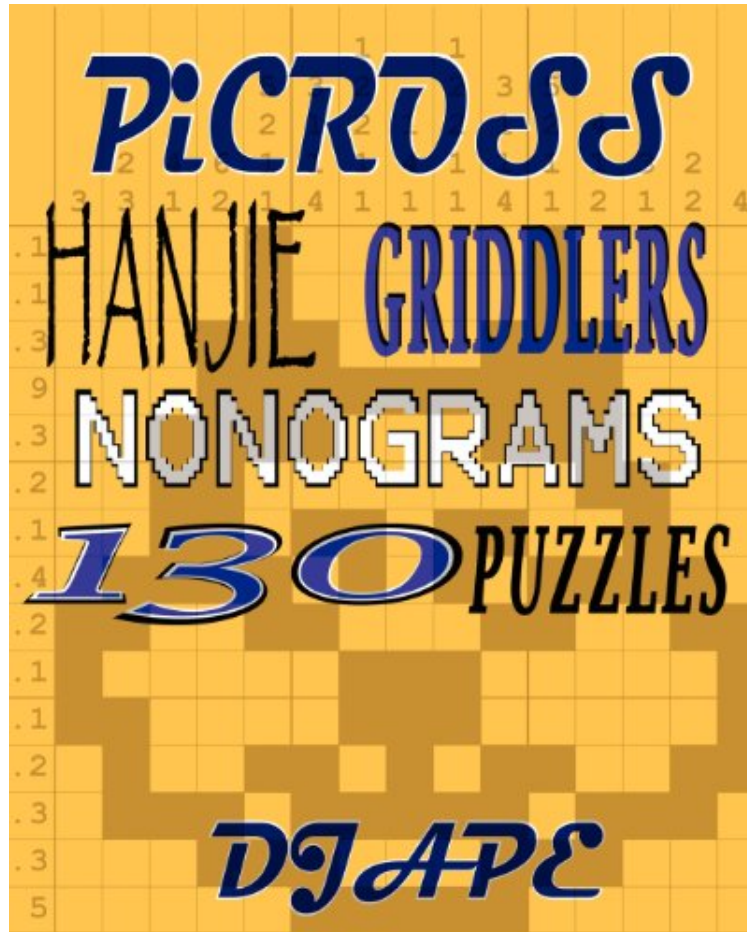

The others are great and made me a major fan of this type of puzzle. But this book goes above and beyond all the rest. The paper is very high quality, for one thing. Publishers need to know how quickly poor quality paper will turn off fans. Second, the pictures might not have titles (and I do miss that) but they are easily recognizable. Third, there is NO guessing in these puzzles. Those who do O'Ekaki will know that sometimes you are reduced to shooting in the dark trying things and guessing till you figure it out. NOT SO with this book. That makes the puzzles a ton more fun! Fourth, the resulting pictures in the bigger grids are absolutely gorgeous! Like other reviewers, I do miss the titles and clues that other puzzle books use, and like at least one other reviewer, I would definitely prefer all my puzzle books to be spiral bound. After discovering them some time back in the UK, There is nothing I spend more time doing than these silly little puzzles; it's become one of the things I am known for and I can't tell you how many lessons I have given to friends on how to solve them... So I run out of puzzles from time to time, as griddlers.net is not accessible from my office (for good reason! I'd never get any work done!) I wind up scouring the internet looking for more paper puzzles.This collection is one I bought earlier this year and I have yet to complete the book; not for any level of difficulty, but for entirely too nit-picky reasons that only truly hardcore hanjie fans will follow... One of the reviewers hit my biggest complaint earlier... the binding/paper quality is wretched. Too large, unbend-able, and the paper is entirely too easy to streak. after working a few puzzles in this book, my entire right hand is black! This is in no way the fault of the authors, and may seem a minor complaint - but enough for me to write a review about it...My other complaint was also slightly mentioned... there are a handful of puzzles that literally turn out looking more like art for art's sake - there is no telling what these pictures turn out to be. There is one in the beginning of the book that I still can't figure out that no one I have shown it to can guess either.I don't know how to mention the other complaint without sounding like a total snob... If you are a hardcore hanjie fan and love a challenge, the first half of this book is going to bug you. Way too easy. Trust the tags on each puzzle, when they say easy, boy are they easy. Can't stand it!but hey, in a pickle (or a complete hanjie withdrawal crisis) this book will certainly do!

These puzzles are also known as paint-by-numbers or pic-a-pix. Whatever you call them, they're fun to solve. As you progress through a puzzle an image starts appearing and by the time you're finished a beautiful drawing is revealed. There are no trivial and too small puzzles in this book. Most of them range from 20x20 to 40x40 in size, which is optimal for solving and image quality. There are also a few bigger ones for those who like a tougher challenge.
