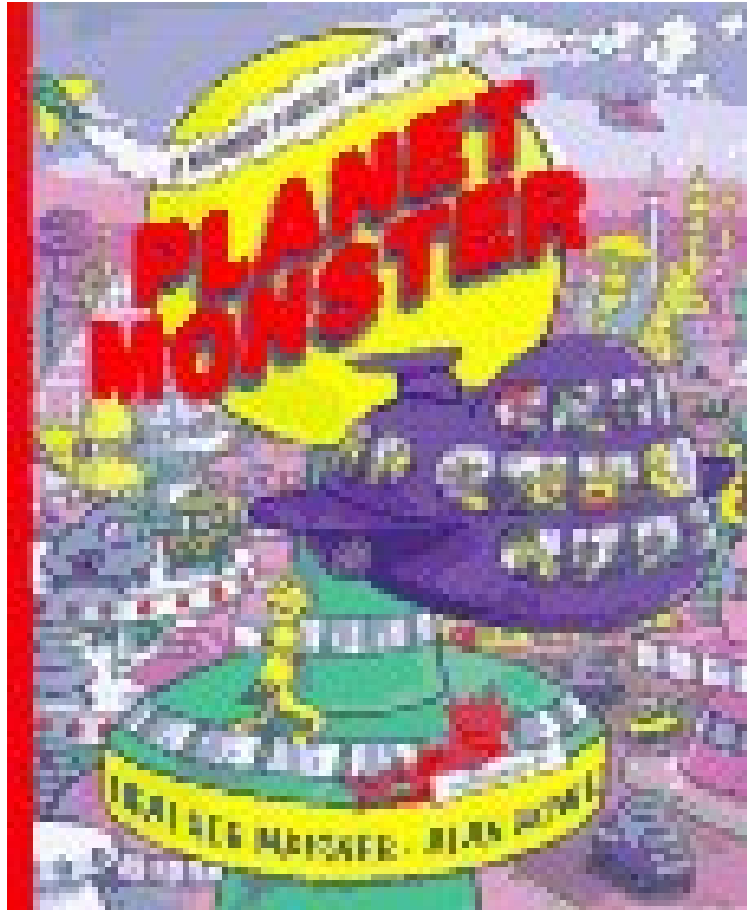

With the goal of saving the planet, readers move from zone to zone according to the sums, remainders, etc., deducing and seeing a lot of funny, far-out monsters as they go. Double-page, brightly colored

cartoons show Dinozapps sitting in volcanoes, Zingies snorkeling, four-footed Plinkies choosing shoes, and Zobbies buying chocolate bars. But only entering zone 15 allows readers to stop the Mad Mathematician and save the universe. The frustration quotient may be too high for the targeted audience, but kids will nevertheless have fun with the bizarre, benign creatures inhabiting Planet Monster.
