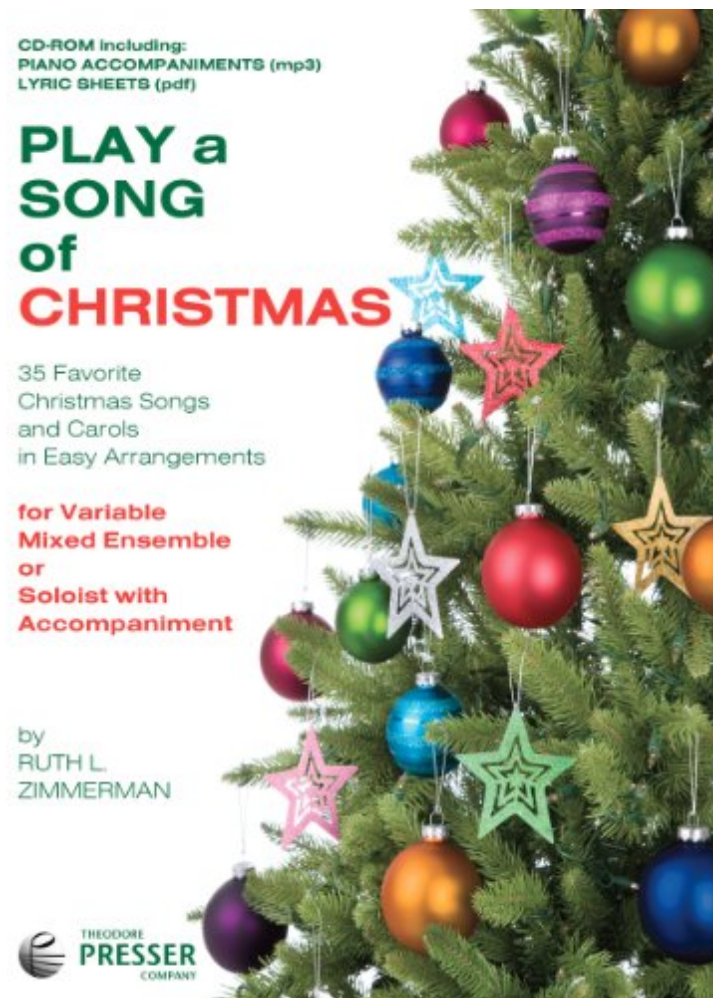

Each book has the melody line (Part A) as well as a nice harmony line, so you can get together with family and friends and form a real ensemble - not just a bunch of people playing in unison.I currently own the Violin Book (with Parts A and B) as well as the Alto Sax (Parts A and C), Tenor Sax (Parts A and C), and Clarinet (Parts A and B). The tenor sax and clarinet are both Bb instruments, so I have Parts A, B, and C covered for any friends who show up with other Bb instruments (trumpet, etc.). I plan to buy the Piano book to complete my "set".I am not familiar with every tune in the book, but it certainly covers all of my favorites and I had a great time this past Christmas jamming with my friends at the music store and at home with the family.0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. Probably works with viola as well (I don't see anything that requires the e-string and everything can be played in first position on G,D,A strings). Good for beginners trying to learn to sight read and to trade parts between melody and harmony. Compared with Suzuki, I would guess book 2 for difficulty of playing solo melody, book 3 for trying to play harmony accompanist while your teacher plays melody (you got to learn to count!).Cons:1. There are no words to accompany the notes (or is this a pro for learners?).2. In one or two short half page songs is that there is a stupid page turn in the middle of the song!
