It's written so that most anyone can understand it. It does explain when to Hit, Stand, Split and Double-Down. Of course, it was written at a time when the rules were a little different, and the player was confined to a Single-Deck Blackjack game, where the Dealer doesn't have to hit a Soft 17, doesn't have to "burn" the top card and can deal to the end of the deck.
