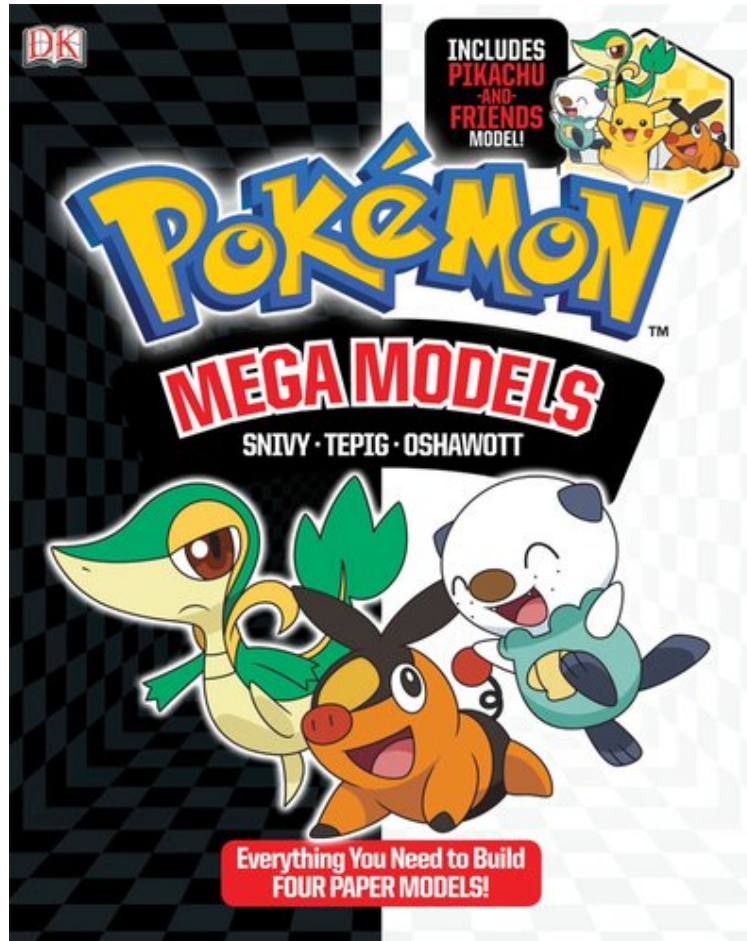

I bought it for my girlfriend, who loves both Pokemon and art projects. This was the perfect afternoon activity, and she spend a good few hours assembling these. The book comes with absolutely all the parts we needed to assemble the three Pokemon (and the cute little Pikachu cutouts), so no taping, stapling, or glue was needed. This is a great gift for a kid, or even (in our case) a grown-up kid, who enjoys building things, and who loves Pokemon. Roman Papercraft has gotten huge in the last 8 years or so, with tons of patterns out there made by fans for characters from movies, games, books, everything you can think of. I don't know why I never picked up a book with the models in them, but my daughter got this Pokemon book for one of her Christmas presents the other day, and I ended up clearing out most of the book within 30 minutes. Not only are these models easy to put together, but they look really good when complete. This book features three 3D models: Oshawott, Tepig and Snivy, and then a big flat display of the three Pokemon and Pikachu too. No glue or tape is needed to make these guys, since they're put together just by folding the paper and inserting tabs here and there. People who haven't gotten into papercraft yet should have no problem pulling off these characters without messing up. There are directions for building each character, telling you what to fold, where to insert the tabs, and if you need to slightly bend a piece in order to make it fit. There aren't that many pieces, so there's not much of a risk of losing pieces when you punch them out. The paper is fairly thick, and when they're done, the Pokemon stand up without any problems. All three of the starters look terrific when constructed, but my favorite of the bunch has to be Tepig because of that smile he has. The models are bigger than I expected too. The last pages of the book feature the 3 and Pikachu that, when put together, make a nice display for any room. I'll definitely be using this one for my daughter's Pokemon-themed birthday party in 2 months. The only thing to watch out for when putting these together is to make sure you're careful when popping the pieces out of the book, and that you don't bend the tabs too much. A few parts of my Pokemon got a little ripped, but it's not very noticeable, and it's nothing that tape can't fix if it comes down to it. I recommend being VERY careful when punching out Tepig's tail because it's such a thin piece. Now that we have these little guys, I'm hoping that other books get released with older Pokemon. I'd love to have a Marowak, Miltank, Eevee, Torkoal and Drifblim join them on the shelf. Then again, I'll be checking around for the patterns via image searches in just a minute since I'm sure they're out there. This book makes for a great activity for kids to do, and it's not very expensive either. For any Pokemon fan in your life, this would be a perfect present.
