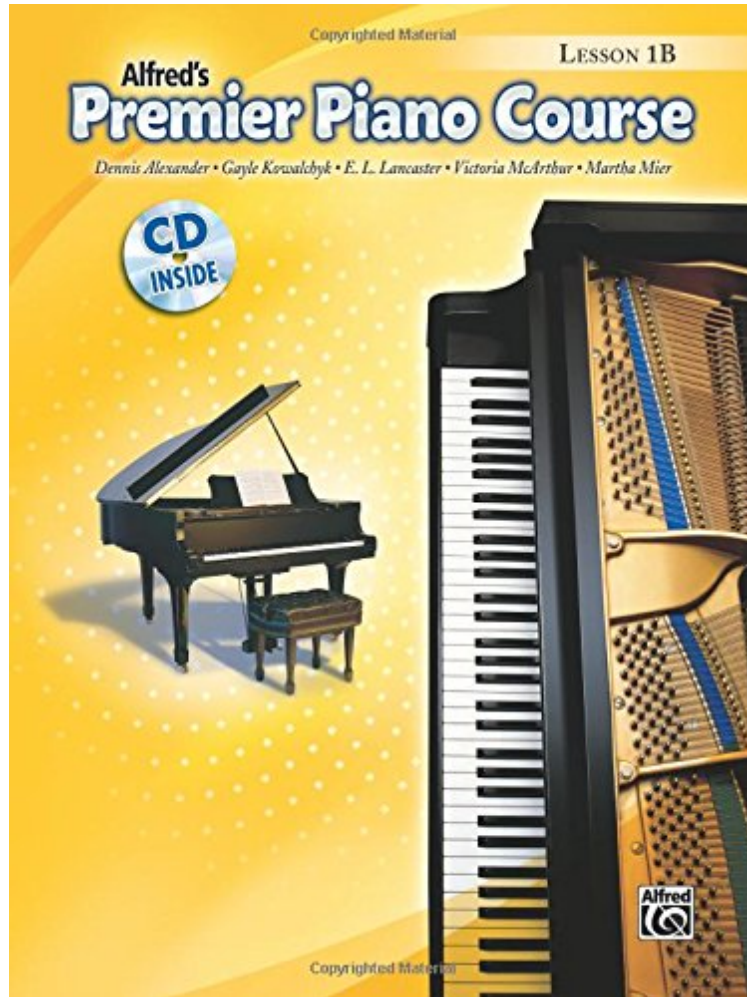

I would add that most songs in this series are solid stand-alone solos, and also feature beautifully scored teacher duets, which afford the students weekly opportunities to make live music with another musician!! The teacher duets are in the tradition of the classics (often based on specific and named classical

pieces), jazz, and eclectic accompaniment styles, so the student's musical taste is further developed. Slam dunk! One more note about duets: teachers, our part is a tad more complicated than the accompaniments, say, in the same level of Faber.
