characterization. there are sections for special interest, almost all of them pretty funny, of various lengths, and usable in different settings: for example, lawyers, doctors, engineers, etc. the few very slightly off-color jokes are never coarse and usually variants of straight jokes. for a paperback, it is well-printed and strongly bound. 's price, as usual, is a solid buying point.
