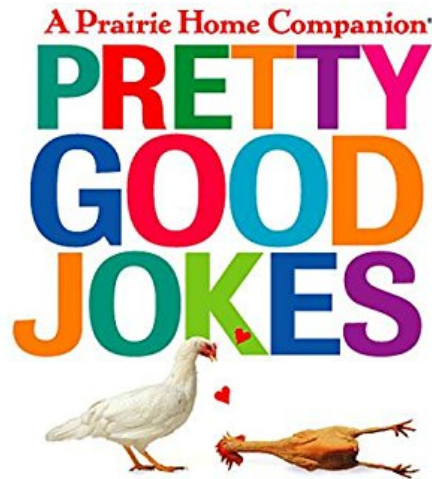

's price, as usual, is a solid buying point.
