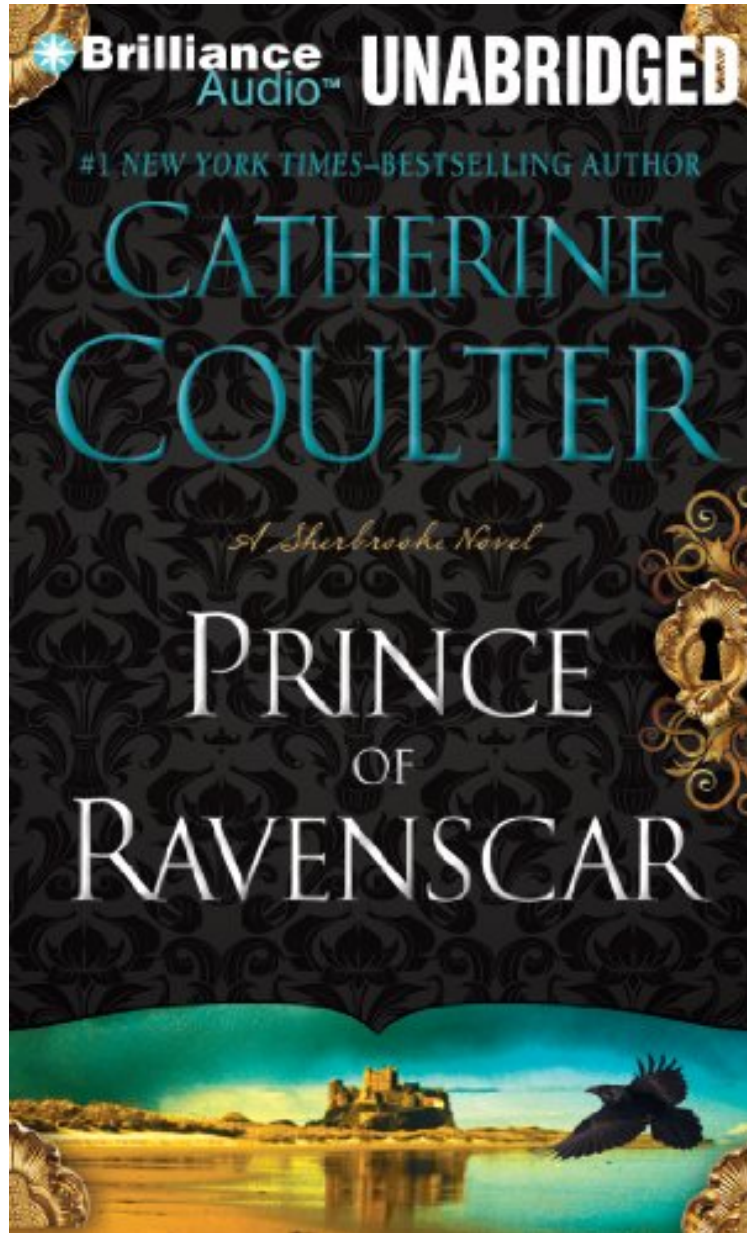

Instead of having helpless females, she adds Sophie Wilkie and her aunt Roxanne Radcliff, who defy the damsel in distress mode, each getting themselves out of bad situations using cunning and brains! By Recluse I was really looking forward to this book since the author always seemed pretty reliable if you wanted a basic good read. I was also in the mood for a gothicky kind of romance. I only got about half way through the book - it seemed like it was written by a Georgette Heyer wanna be that failed miserably. The plot line was choppy and the characters were all so cookie-cutter similar that they were almost impossible to separate. I hate giving a uniformly bad review, but I didn't find anything redeeming in this book. I agree with another reviewer: this may be the last book by this author that I read.
