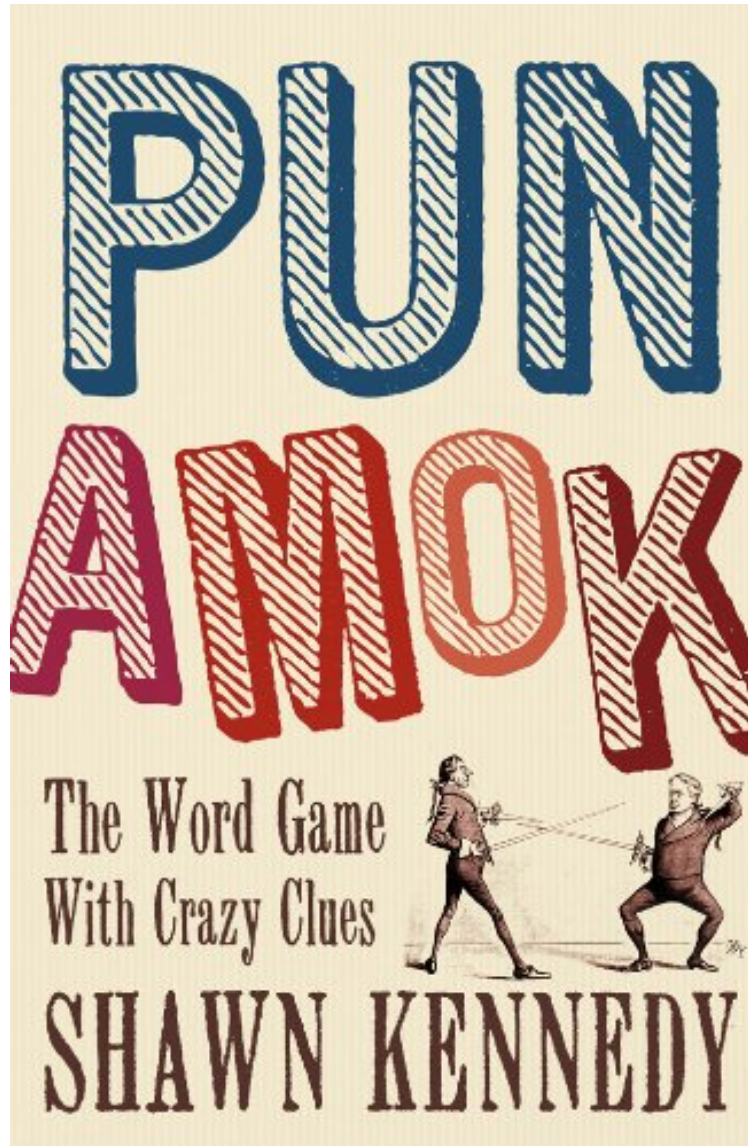

The blanks, where you'd write your solutions down, indicate how long the solution is and also give you one free letter. For example: Stamp collector / _ _ _ _ _ O _ _ There are also break-ins in the blanks so that the actual puzzle looks something like: _ _ / _ _ _ / O / _ _ Below each page are

numerous 2 and 3-letter tiles. You combine several of these tiles to answer each clue. The answer to the puzzle above is PASSPORT so in that page, you'd cross out the tiles that read PA, SSA and RT. Once you've crossed out all the tiles that answered the 6 clues, the remaining tiles combine to answer the Bonus Clue, also below the page. I don't see why the bonus clue isn't up there with the normal clues the only differences are that they don't have any starting letters and the answers are usually longer. Here are a few more punny examples: Free of charge / ACQUITS Some of them have small fortunes / COOKIES They live off the land / FISH There are over 100 pages of Pun Amok so you'd be thinking like a punster for a while. 4 of 4 people found the following review helpful. In each puzzle, piece together the 2- and 3-letter word pieces to discover the answers to seven punny clues like "It's open for discussion" (answer: MOUTH) and "Locks up?" (answer: COWLICK). Cross out the word pieces that form the answers to the first six clues, then arrange the leftover word pieces to spell the answer to a Bonus Clue like "A blast from the past?" (answer: THE BIG BANG). These playful puzzles will test your brain and tickle your funny bone! Contains 110 puzzles with 770 clever clues.
