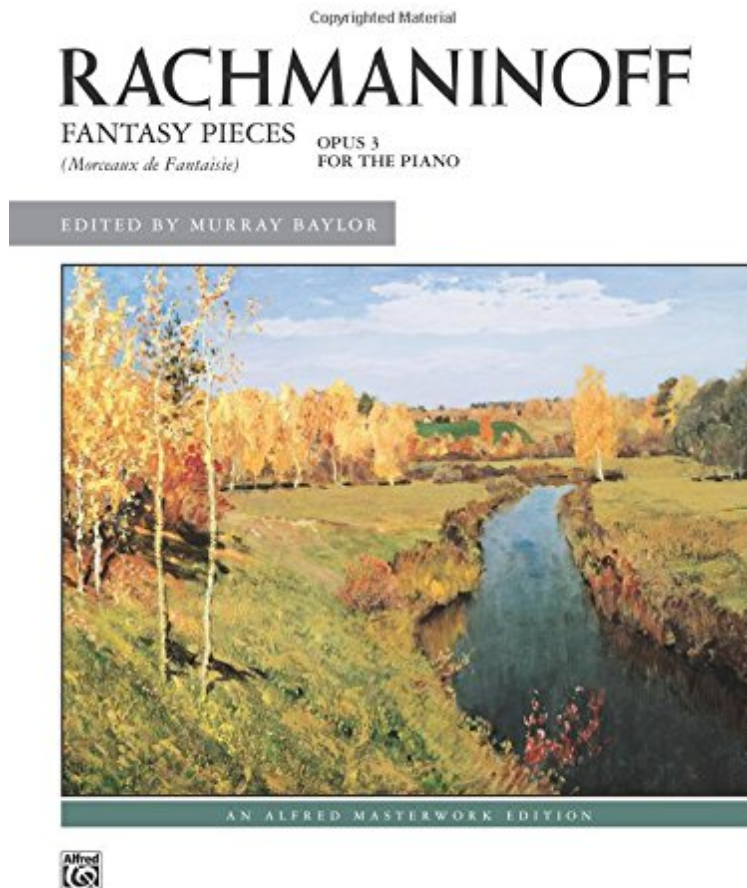

But as this was the only publication that I could find that contained Rachmaninoff's Serenade Op 3. No. 5, I didn't have too much choice. Regardless of my preferences, this is a good little booklet and it is nice to have all the fantasy pieces of

Opus 3 in one collection. The picture on the front is a pretty autumn landscape with a river, as opposed to the round orange and black circle as shown in the picture.
